CH14	Bridleway	From: Clipston-Great Oxendon county road opposite playing field at N.E. end of Clipston village To: S.E. to junction with CH15 at Kelmarsh parish boundary thence S.E. to the Clipston-Kelmarsh county road at Grasslands Farm
CH15	Footpath	From: At junction with CH16 and CH23 at footbridge over stream To: S.E. to junction with CH14 adjoining Kelmarsh parish boundary (junction with CZ3) [CZ3; footpath; From: Clipston parish boundary S.E. of Clipston village (junction with CH14 and CH15) To: S.E. to the Kelmarsh-Clipston county road opposite N. boundary of The Dales (woodland)]
CH16	Footpath	From: Junction with CH15 and CH23 To: S. to junction with CH14
CH17	Footpath	From: High Street Clipston adjacent to No. 4 High Street To: N. to N.W. end of The Green at Harborough Road, S. of 'The Bulls Head' Inn
CH18	Footpath	From: Gold Street at junction with Nobold Court Clipston To: S.E. to Naseby Road S. of the Old Red Lion P.H.
CH21	Footpath	From: Entrance gate at S.W. corner of the churchyard, Clipston To: N.E. crossing the churchyard to junction with CH10
CH23	Footpath	From: Clipston-Kelmarsh county road S. of Bassett Way To: S.E. to junction with CH15 and CH16 at bridge over stream
CH24	Footpath	From: S. side of No. 2 Gold Street, Clipston To: N.E. to CH18
